How do I book a Dial-A-Ride?

You phone the telephone number for the area in which you live, (see the panels overleaf).

Requests for the next day's services will be taken by telephone between 0900 and 1200 daily, (In Bicester, because of the opening hours of Shopmobility, requests for Dial-A-Ride journeys are taken between 0930 and 1200 daily). Please give our staff as much flexibility as possible regarding the time you wish to travel. Between 1200 and 1400 daily, the following day's schedules will be drawn up to make the fullest use of our buses and to satisfy the maximum number of requests received.

How much will it cost?



If you need Extra Assistance?
